In Greenwood, Southern Oaks products are offered at the Pantry Shop on the by-pass, close to Calhoon. Best option is to go directly to the store on the farm where products are available all day.

Raw milk from cows feeding on grass is the best option for both health and nutrition. I visited the farm in early spring and saw a small operation with 56 cows who grazed on grass all year long, supplemented with hay in the winter months. Mr. Wiley takes great care of his animals; commercial operations use Holstein cows, contained in pens and fed an unnatural diet of grains and given antibiotics and growth hormone to bolster milk production.

Did you know South Carolina is one of the rare states where raw milk is legal? Take advantage of your privilege and visit Southern Oaks Jersey Farm and Creamery in Abbebille, or online.
